

RESIZE PHOTO FILES with PHOTOSHOP IMAGE PROCESSOR

Use Adobe Bridge to select the files to be processed. From there the files are opened and batch processed in Photoshop Image Processor. This process is necessary to resize the files for the Hyper-Duplet page to 400 x 600 pixels (or 600 pixels max.)

in Adobe Bridge

run Adobe Bridge
navigate to the folder containing all of your photos
select all photographs
 EDIT> SELECT ALL [CMD] A
resize the photos
 TOOLS> PHOTOSHOP> IMAGE PROCESSOR...

in Adobe Photoshop

1- Select images to process
 this will process all pictures from Bridge
2- Select location to save processed images
 save in same location
 a new folder named JPEG will be created,
 no files will be overwritten
3- File type
 Save as JPEG (necessary for web display)
 quality = 10
 convert profile to sRGB
 Resize to fit
 width = 600 px, height = 600 px
 this will set the maximum width or height
 and will 'constrain proportions'
hit [RUN] button
