

## Extracting Audio from a DVD

### Insert DVD

### Run Mac the Ripper

- click the [MODE] button

  - choose [TITLE - CHAPTER EXTRACTION]

- select which titles and/or chapters you want to extract

- click the [D] button and the [STREAMS] button will be activated

- click on the [STREAMS] button

  - a drawer will pop out showing the available streams

- de-select your video stream and any unnecessary audio streams

- click [GO]

  - wait as MtR dumps an .ac3 file onto your hard drive

  - it will also put an empty VIDEO\_TS folder there

    - ignore it or delete

repeat for as many titles/ chapters need to be extracted

### Run mAC3dec

- select an .ac3 File from File>Open

  - set the Format to AIFF

  - set the Samples Rate to 44.1 kHz

- hit [START]

- the AIFF file will be deposited in the same folder

  - as the source .ac3 file

### Run Toast

- select the Audio option

- create a new disc

  - name the disc

- drag each AIFF into the Toast window

- set all pauses to 0

  - except the first track

- hit the [BURN] button
